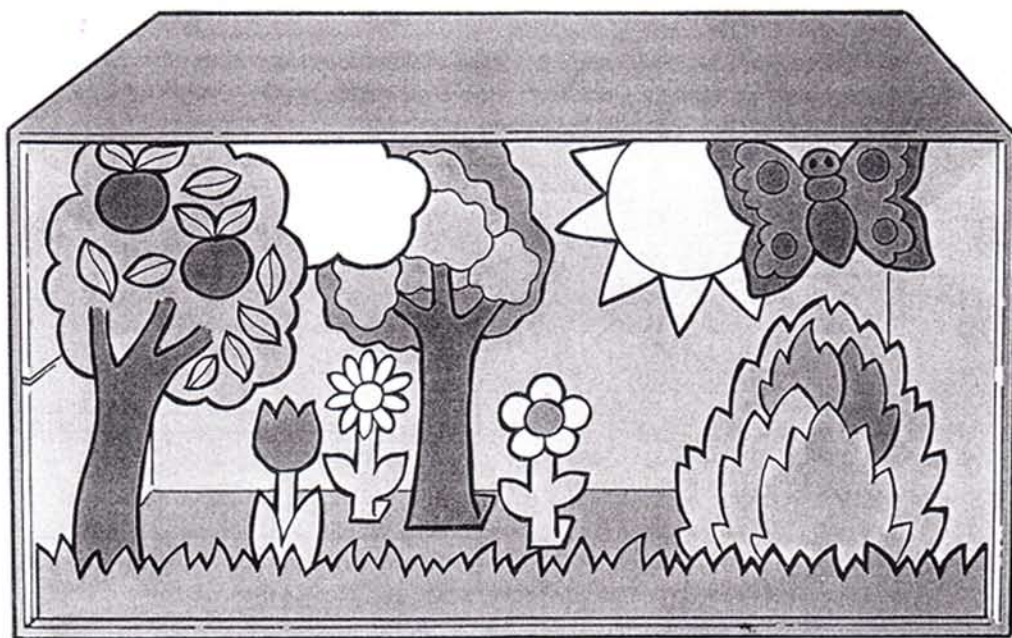




## Golden Girl's garden

The children in Letterland love to play in Golden Girl's gorgeous garden. Golden Girl will show you how to make a garden just like hers.

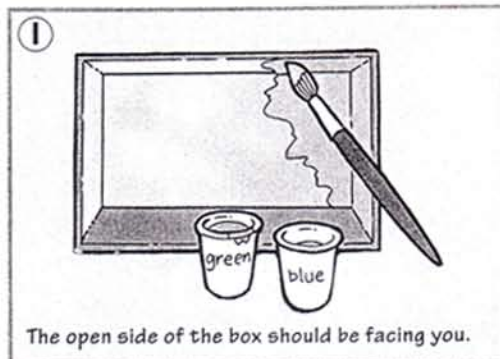


### You will need

- ☀ 1 shoe box
- ☀ Card
- ☀ 1 piece of tracing or greaseproof paper
- ☀ Green and blue paint

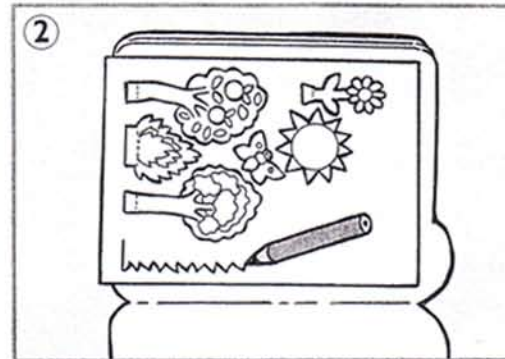
### Annie Apple's advice

- ☀ Use the pictures on page 24 to make as many trees, flowers and clouds as you like.
- ☀ Keep the lid of the shoe box to protect your garden when you carry it around or when you store it.

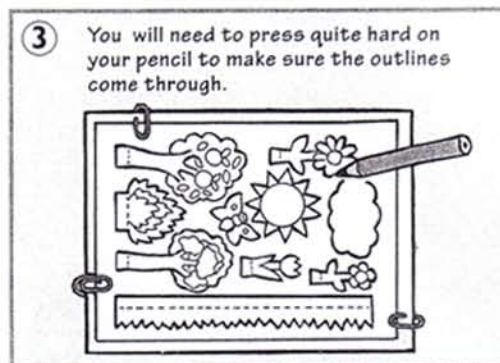


The open side of the box should be facing you.

▲ Turn the box on its side. Paint the floor green. Paint the sides, back and inside ceiling blue.



▲ Turn to page 24. Put the tracing paper over the page and trace over the pictures with a pencil.

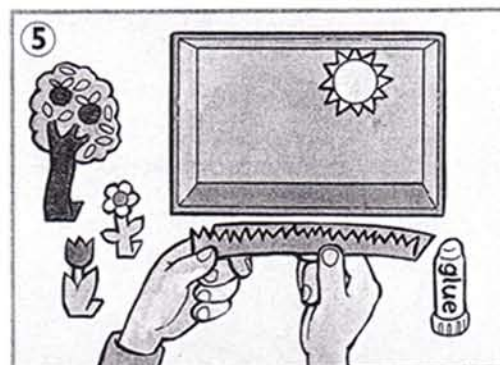


3 You will need to press quite hard on your pencil to make sure the outlines come through.

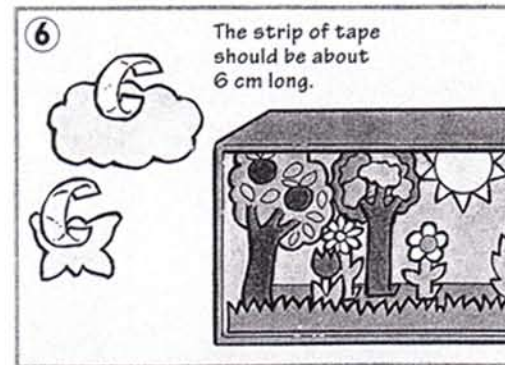
▲ Put the tracing paper on the card. Go over the lines so the outlines appear on the card.



▲ Draw over the outlines on the card in pencil. Colour the pictures with felt-tip pens. Cut out the shapes.



▲ Glue the sun to the back of the box. Fold back the bases of the flowers, trees and grass. Glue to the floor of the box.



The strip of tape should be about 6 cm long.

▲ Stick half a strip of sticky tape to the back of the cloud and half to the box ceiling. Stick the butterfly the same way.
